## **OFF-LICENCE**

Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 <u>Pembroke Wines and Spirits Limited</u> is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **24 Dungarvon Street**, **Wanaka**, **Queenstown Lakes District** and known as "**Pembroke Wines and Spirits Wanaka**" to any person for consumption off the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

## **CONDITIONS**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours: **Monday to Sunday 9:00 am to 11:00 pm**
- (c) Freely available drinking water must be provided to all customers at all times alcohol is being sold and supplied.
- (d) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed: display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions of the supply of alcohol to minors and the prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons, identification of minors.
- (e) The following part of the premises is designated **supervised** the entire time: **the small front room** in accordance with the plans received on the 8<sup>th</sup> May 2019.
- (f) According to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Fees) Regulations 2013 the premises is assigned the fees category: **Medium Tavern.**

## **DURATION**

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- a) Eitheri)
- Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
- ii) If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either
  - i) Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - ii) If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
